Ballet director at HNK-Zagreb

Massimiliano Volpini is a choreographer, stage director, video maker and artistic director of events related to dance and music. He began studying classical dance at a very young age in the school of Maestro Giuseppe Urbani. As a dancer he worked for Venice Ballet, Arena di Verona, Comunale di Firenze, Massimo di Palermo, Ljubljana Opera and Teatro alla Scala, where he remained until 2014. He danced in all the most important ballets of the classical repertoire, and he worked with some of the 20th century masters of choreography such as Roland Petit, Rudolf Nureyev, Mats Ek, Maurice Bejart, Uwe Scholtz and many others. He created choreographies for Teatro alla Scala, Tulsa Ballet, Zagreb Biennale, New York Choreographic Institute, Balletto di Roma, Regio di Torino, Rome Opera Theatre, Kiel Opera, Opéra de Bordeaux. Between 1998 and 2010 he was one of the founders and curators of Balletto.net, a web portal which has become an important point of reference for all dance enthusiasts in Italy. Starting from January 2023 Massimiliano Volpini is the Ballet Director of the Croatian National Theatre in Zagreb.

Leo Mujic is an international choreographer who created ballets for: Croatian National Theatre in Zagreb, Croatian National Theater in Split, Slovenian National Theatre Ljubljana and Maribor, Latvian National Ballet Riga, Macedonian National Ballet, Bulgarian National Ballet Plovdiv, Ballet Theatre Metz, Tokyo City Ballet, the State Ballet Berlin, the State Ballet Augsburg, Friedrich Statt Palast Berlin, He has created an independent project with the soloists of the new National Ballet in Tokyo, a solo for Aurelie Dupont, who performs with the Paris Opera Ballet, solo for David Halberg ABT, for the Jacob's Pillow Dance Festival in Massachusetts, the Holland Dance Festival, the SBBS (Schweizerische Ballett Berufs Schule) in Zurich, the National Theatre in Pécs and Györ, Evolution Dance Company Budapest, Dance Academy Budapest among others. Recently he profiled himself in a full-length dramatic story ballets such as Midsummer Night's Dream, Ana Karenina, Seherezade and her Tales, Gospoda Glembajevi, Dangerous Liaisons, Orffeus, The Great Gatsby, Pride and Prejudice, The wooden Prince. As a Director/Choreographer he made Disney's Beauty and the Beast, Jesus Christ Superstar musicals, with Theatre Komedija in Zagreb.

Ken Ludden

Artistic Director Margot Fonteyn Academy of Ballet

Ken Ludden is the Co-Founder and Artistic Director of the Margot Fonteyn Academy of Ballet, Lead Trustee of the Fonteyn-Leung Educational Trust, and Director of Fonteyn Fine Arts International. He has more than 4 dozen books in print about ballet and other subjects and is a choreographer and teacher. MFAB has programs in South Africa, Latvia, New Zealand, Australia, the United States, England and Japan.

Ludden took his first dance classes at the age of 3. He went on to study and excel in ballet, and at the age of 15 met Dame Margot Fonteyn. The next year Fonteyn arranged for Ludden to live with her mother, Hilda Hookham, in London and study at the Royal Ballet School, and soon after was moved to company class with the Royal Ballet Company as a student, not a company member.

Ludden began dancing professionally at 18 and had an international career. During that time, he developed a dance partnership with American ballerina Sallie Wilson, and the two had four ballets created for them, which they toured around the world. Ludden also choreographed ballets starting at age 18.


In 1978, he founded Summergate Dance Theater to provide professional stage artists work during their off-season weeks. In 1982, the company became National Arts Group, and the company performances became known as Les Ballets du Monde. Ludden still directs both groups and continues to provide performance opportunities to dancers from all over the world.

Ludden's work with Fonteyn had many facets, including teaching her private classes with Nureyev and guests they invited. They worked on productions, both on stage and off, and joined efforts in some writing projects and creation of ballet class accompaniment albums. Ludden is the only person to whom Fonteyn gave written permission for the use of her name, and together they created the Academy Method of teaching, and co-founded The Margot Fonteyn Academy of Ballet.

His directing credits include: the Stadttheater Luzern Ballet Company, Les Ballets du Monde, the Kennedy Center Tribute to Rudolf Nureyev, Mary Go-Round (a television pilot), AIDS Theater Festival Productions, the US Memorial Service for Dame Margot Fonteyn, and assistant director (to Frank Rizzo) of the Wolf Trap Opera Company, and many others. He has choreographed over 100 ballets, and as a choreographer was the US offering in the first cultural exchange with the USSR in 1989.



In 2018, Ludden celebrated 50 years of teaching classical ballet. He has taught and coached many leading dancers including Principals of the Boston Ballet, ABT, Donetsk Ballet, Moscow Festival Ballet, Kirov Ballet Soloists, and individual leading artists. Currently, he works regularly with 50 dancers, each a principal dancer or top soloist in a major ballet companies around the world.

Almira Osmanović, was a prima ballerina since 1990 and CNT Split Ballet Artistic director since 2002. She received her first ballet education in Zagreb with renowned ballet pedagogue Silvia Hercigonja. As a very talented and prosperous ballet artist she won the scholarship for Academy for Choreography and Ballet "Agripina Vaganova" in St.Petersburg where she graduated in the class of the famous pedagogue Ludmila Safronova. In 1979, she became a soloist of the Croatian National Ballet in Zagreb and very soon principal dancer. Her repertoire includes all principal roles in classical, contemporary and national ballet titles. In 1990 she becomes the national prima ballerina. She worked with renowned choreographers such as: Vaczlav Orlikowsky, Peter Breuer, Milko Šparemblek , Vasco Wellenkamp, Joseph Nagy and others. From 1994 until 2002 she was the Artistic Directress of the Croatian National Ballet in Zagreb. In 2002 Almira Osmanović become was the Artistic Directress of the Ballet of the Split Croatian National Theatre. GUEST Dinu Tamazlacaru

Principal dancer at Berlin Opera House Winner of Prix de Lausanne

Dinu Tamazlacaru started his first dancing steps in his hometown Chisinau at the Moldavian ballet school under the direction of Jurie Gorshkov and Alexander Iwanov, from 1994 to 2000. He improved his dancer's formation two more years at the Ballet Conservatory of Vienna supervised by Karl Musil. Evelyn Tery And Maxim Abzalov. As a young professional dancer, he won prestigious awards such as the gold medal of the Australian ballet and dance contest in 2001, the gold medal of the international competition Arabesk at Perm and the Prix de Lausanne in 2002.

In the same year, Vladimir Malhakov proposes him to join the corps de ballet of the Staatsoper Unter den Linden transformed in 2004 in Staatsballett Berlin that he still belongs to as the Principal dancer. He develops his qualities of artist through a rich repertoire of the famous classical main roles : Sigfried in Swan Lake (Patrice Bart/Petipa/Yereomenko), Basil in Don Quichoxe (Petipa/Derevianko/Grigorovich/Messerer), Romeo (John Cranko/Patrice Bart), Lensky in Onegin (John Cranko) the prince of Nutcracker (Patrice Bart/Grigorovich/Medvedev,Boulaka), James or Gurn in La Sylphide (Schaufuss/Bournonville, Solor, Golden Idole, Solo fakir in Bajadere (Vladimir Malakhov), Le Papillon in Glories of romantic ballet (Pierre Lacottes), Marquitanka (Pierre Lacotte), Tchaikovsky Pas de deux, Tarentella, pas de deux (Balnchine), Fancy free (Jerome Robbins), Franz in Coppelia (Roland Petit);

Also in neoclassical or modern pieces: The Vertiginous thrill of exactitude, Herman Schmerman (William Forsythe), Baccus in Carravaggio (Mauro Bigonzetti), And the sky (Marco Goecke), Arlesienne (Roland Petit), Siegfried and Mime in Ring um den Ring (Maurice Béjart), Les bourgeois (Ben van Couwenberg).

In 2012, his amazing ability of interpretation is recognized by one of the most prestigious price of Germany for an artist (all categories included), the Daphné price and wins the "Mr Expressivity" at the Dance Open. His career is not limited to Germany but fully international: he participates in many gala events all over the world (Italy, Japan, France, Finland, Swiss, Kazakhstan, Russia, Romania, China, Mexico, United State...), and gets invited for guesting to the main theaters of ballet world as Teatro Opera di Roma, Teatro communale Firenze Maggio Danza, Tokyo ballet, Mikhailovsky theater Saint Petersburg, Opera National of Kazan, Ufa, Bucharest, Zagreb, Bratislava.

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Mihaela Devald Roksandić

Principal dancer & Ballet Mistress at HNK Zagreb

In 1988 she becomes a permanent member of the HNK Ballet ensemble in Zagreb. After professional training at the Moscow State Academy of Choreography (MAHU) she gradually builds her career to become the first principal dancer in 2003. During her career, she performed many major roles in both classical and modern ballet repertoire.

From 2012 to 2014, she cooperates with the School of Classical Ballet in Zagreb as an external associate.

In 2016, she becomes ballet master of the Ballet of the Croatian National Theatre in Zagreb and finishes her undergraduate studies in ballet pedagogy at the Academy of Dramatic Art in Zagreb. Three years later, she finishes graduate studies in Pedagogy at the Faculty of Philosophy in Zagreb. Since 2014 she has published expert articles and texts in the field of dance and pedagogy.

In the 2022/23 season she was appointed acting director of the HNK Ballet in Zagreb. In her career she has won many prestigious awards, for her ballet performances and overall professional work.

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Staša Zurovac

Choreographer

Staša Zurovac is a dancer and choreographer, and the former leading soloist of the Croatian National Theatre (CNT) Ballet in Zagreb. He graduated from the Croatian Ballet School in Zagreb in the class of Professor Tatjana Lucić-Šarić. He continued his studies in St. Petersburg at the Vaganova Ballet Academy where he graduated under the supervision of V. K. Onoschko. He collaborated with many world-renowned choreographers such as Milko Šparemblek, Martino Müller, Ted Brandsen, Vasco Wellenkamp, Gagik Ismailian, Peter Breuer, Dinko Bogdanić, Patrick Delcroix and many others. From 1996 until 1999 he danced in the dance ensemble *Compania Portuguesa de Bailado Contemporaneo*. With the choreographer Mark Boldin he started an independent arts organization the *Atelier Choréographique*. From 2003 until 2012 he was the Director of the Croatian National Theatre Ballet Ivan pl. Zajc in Rijeka. From 2012 until 2018 has worked at the University of Rijeka as a guest lecturer at the studies *Acting, Media and Culture*. He is the choreographer, author and director of numerous choreographies, full-evening ballets, dance pieces and drama plays. He is the winner of the following awards:

Grand Prix Award and Audience Award for the choreography of The Fiancées Dream at the 5th Festival of Choreographic Miniatures in Belgrade; Second Award at the 17th International Competition for Choreographers in Hannover for the choreography of The Fiancées Dream; Croatian Acting Award for best young artist's creative work for the works *The Fiancees Dream* and *Please, Wake me up*; Peristyl Music Award of the Morning Paper for the best musicalscenic performance at the Split Summer Festival for the ballets *The Gods Aren't Angry* and *Daj, Daj* and for the ballet *Daïssa-East of Eden*; Boris Papandopulo Award for the best ballet of the season 2004/2005 at the Croatian National Theatre Ballet Ivan pl. Zajc in Rijeka; Dimitrije Parlić Award of the Association of Ballet Artists of Serbia; Award of the City of Belgrade and the Annual Award of the National Theatre for the ballet *Who Is Singing Over There?*; Croatian Acting Award for best contemporary dance piece *Cirkus primitif balet* (CNT Ivan pl. Zajc in Rijeka); Award of the City of Rijeka for the exceptional artistic achievements and exceptional contribution to the success of the Ballet of the CNT Ivan

Ballet Dancer / Pedagogue Assistant of choreographer Eduard Clug

Mirjana Šrot is a Slovenian ballet dancer, she graduated from the Maribor Conservatory of Music and Ballet and continued her study in Vienna at the Konservatorium Wien Privatuniversität. In 2010, she joined the Slovene National Theatre Maribor where she performed in all classical ballet performances such as Swan Lake, Sleeping Beauty, Giselle, Nutcracker, La Fille mal gardee, Don Quixote, Romeo and Juliet, Carmen, Le Corsaire, Zorba the Greek, Eugene Onegin, La Sylphide, Paquita. She has also performed in contemporary performances of the most prominent choreographers such as Edward Clug (Peer Gynt, Rite of Spring, Carmina Burana, Povodni Mož, Les noces, Hora, Stabat Mater, Tango, Kekec, ...) Jiří Kylián (Falling Angels), Johan Inger (Walking Mad, Rain Dogs), Mauro Bigonzetti (Cantata), Zoran Marković (The Golden Age), Staša Zurovac (Nychthemeron), etc.ln 2021, she started to work as an Assistant Choreographer for Edward Clug's Peer Gynt. She worked with Croatian National Theatre in Zagre b, Slovenian National Theatre Maribor for the performances in Bonn, Ludwigsburg, Modena and Maribor. In 2013, she joined the team of a private ballet school. Her students have been regularly winning first prizes at ballet competitions. In 2022, Mirja na received the Best Teacher Award at International Ballet Competition Tutu. In 2021 and 2022, she worked as a ballet teacher at the International Summer Ballet Camp Dancs-Piran. In 2020, she became a certified Progressing Ballet Technique Teacher.





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Anton Bogov

National Principal Dancer at SNG Maribor

He began his ballet studies in Moscow and finished them in Alma-Ata, Kazakhstan. During his schooling, he already performed at many school events and theatre performances. After the ballet competition in the summer of 1993 in Moscow, his successful international promotion began. That summer, he got a job at the Ochi International Ballet Theater in Nagoya, Japan, where he is still a permanent guest ballet dancer. Already in the summer of 1994, he joined the ballet ensemble of the Opera and Ballet of the SNG in Maribor, where he still creates today. In the summer of 1996, due to his qualities, he became one of the most prominent soloists of the ballet ensemble. In 1998, he received Slovenian citizenship.

Today, Anton Bogov is the first soloist of the Maribor Ballet, as a guest he also performs with other ensembles, including SNG Ljubljana, Opera Graz, Austria, Croatian National Theater Zagreb, National Theater Prague, Czech Republic, International Ballet Theater Ochi, Nagoya, Japan, Atlanta Theater, Georgia, USA and at many international festivals around the world. With his extensive knowledge of a classical ballet dancer, he works with more modern choreography.

Who can participate?

Professional dancers, recreational dancers with intermediate to advanced knowledge of classical or modern ballet, and students at ballet high schools (minimum 13 years of age with a written parental approval) and ballet academies are eligible to attend.

When is the deadline date to register?

We don't have a registration deadline, but we do recommend you register in time as the availability is limited.
